Constable Michael Gee and Mr. Rob Schuckel, of Island Health presented to the Board.

Integrated Mobile Crisis Response Team (IMCRT) is a collaboration between Child, Youth and Family Mental Health (CYFMH) Services, Adult Mental Health and Addiction Services and Greater Victoria police departments.

Child and youth mental health clinicians work alongside adult mental health clinicians, social workers, nurses and plain-clothes police officers to provide a rapid, mobile, community-based response to children, youth and families in crisis.
